The purpose of the employment was to make a Ph.D. proposal about Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) and apply for funding for it (no funding obtained). The title of the proposal was: *Transferring Corporate Social Responsibility to Companies in the Developing Countries – the Case of Co-Operating Danish and Indian Businesses*. The aim of the planned dissertation was to investigate how and to what extent CSR was being diffused from Danish to Indian companies, and to examine the development potential of diffused CSR. A goal was also to examine specific corporate legitimacy crises in an Indian context. The purpose was to come to a better understanding of how these "moral panics" worked. This part of the study would have focused on the communication between companies, local media, and the public. Finally, it would have been discussed whether and how CSR-issues should have been integrated more explicitly into Denmark's development policy so that business promotion could have addressed Danida's cross-cutting issues more efficiently.

The Industrialization Fund for the Developing Countries (IFU) was contacted in order to identify potential case-studies. Cheminova, Roulunds, and FLSmidt were willing to consider being a part of the case-study if the necessary funding for the dissertation was obtained.

Furthermore, the job consisted of fundraising, planning study groups, and arranging research seminars, workshops, and conferences.
